Mail in entries will only be accepted from April 24<sup>th</sup> thru May 8<sup>th</sup>.

- Judge and Steward registration will begin at 9:30 a.m. First round judging will start at 10:00 a.m. in a closed session. Best-of-Show will begin at 4:00 p.m. and will be open to the public. Ribbons and prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places per category and Best-of-Show.
- A raffle of beer and homebrewing related items will be held after the Best-of-Show round.

### **Official Rules & Regulations:**

1. This competition is open to all homebrewers. All entries must be brewed at home. No commercially produced brews, please! The current BJCP Style Guidelines will be used. Please refer to <http://www.bjcp.org/> to check the latest style descriptions and numbers.
2. Brewers may enter any subcategory only once. Categories will be collapsed at the discretion of the judge director.
3. All entries must be accompanied by an ENTRY/RECIPE form. Entry fees are \$5.00 per entry. Please make checks payable to **Brewers East End Revival**. If you are mailing entries, include the ENTRY/RECIPE forms and the check together in a zip-lock bag.
4. Two bottles are required per entry. Bottles must be 10-25 ounces in volume, brown or green glass, and free from any brand name lettering. Grolsch-style bottles and PET bottles with carbonators are not acceptable. Bottle caps must be free from graphics or blackened out with a permanent marker. A properly completed bottle entry label must be attached to each bottle with rubber bands (no glue or tape). Any entry not meeting these requirements will be disqualified and will not be returned.
5. Entries may be brought to a B.E.E.R. club meeting or dropped off at the above mentioned addresses. It is illegal to ship entries via The United States Postal Service. Entries may be shipped UPS to: Joe Hopp, 6 10th, Wading River, NY 11792. If shipping your entries, carefully pack them in a sturdy box. Line the inside of the box with a plastic bag. Partition and pack each bottle with adequate packing material. It is legal to send beer for evaluation, but to avoid questions from UPS, identify contents as "Yeast Sample" or "Kitchen Supplies" or simply "Fragile."
6. Entries will be accepted between April 24th, 2005 and May 8th, 2005. THIS IS A STRICT DEADLINE! Entries received after the May 8th, 2005 deadline will neither be judged nor returned. [Special Note: On the day of the competition (May 14th, 2005) Judges and Stewards who arrive by 9:30 a.m, may bring with them any beers they have entered AS LONG AS THOSE ENTRIES HAVE BEEN PRE-REGISTERED BY THE MAY 8th DEADLINE. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE!
7. These rules may be changed at any time without notice by the Competition Organizers.
8. Judges and Stewards are needed. If you are a BJCP Judge, an experienced non-BJCP judge, or would like to help steward at this competition, please download the Judge/Steward Waiver form on-line at <http://hbd.org/BEER>, bring the completed form to a B.E.E.R. meeting or to the competition. If you are not web-savvy, you may call Pete Algeria (Judge Director) at 631-924-2554 or Steve Wynhurst (Competition

Organizer) at 631-736-6013. Lunch (grilled meats, salads, pies, etc.) and plenty of beer will be available to all participating Judges and Stewards. AHA/BJCP experience points will be awarded on an as available basis. Judges and stewards should make advance registration with Pete Algerio. A judge registration/waiver must be signed or points will not be submitted. Everyone is welcome to judge or steward.

9. Directions to Nesconset Knights of Columbus Hall, 130 Lake Ave., South Nesconset, Long Island: Take Northern State Parkway to the end. Staying in the left hand lane through Hauppauge, take the left fork onto Rte. 347 (approximately 2 miles from the end of the parkway). About 3 miles from this junction, Rte. 347 crosses Southern Boulevard. Stay on Rte. 347 one more “block” and make the next left onto Lake Avenue (heading North). The hall is on your left about 1/10<sup>th</sup> of a mile north of the intersection with Rte 347.
