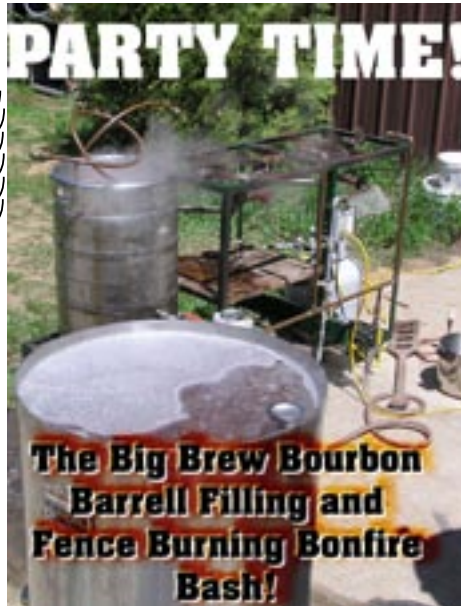
Please bring your own glass and some munchies to share.

BEER RECIPE

Rauchbier



Malzbil

- 5# German Rauchmalt
- 5.5# German Light Munich Malt
- 2# German Vienna
- 1.25# Caravienne
- 0.67# Caramunich
- 0.75# Carapils

- 1# Belgian Aromatic Malt
- 0.25# Honey Malt

Hopfenbil

- 1 oz Saaz (α 3.6%) for 90 minutes
- 0.5 oz Hal. Mittlefrue (α 4%) for 30 min
- 0.5 oz Hal. Mittlefrue (α 4%) for 15 min

Double decoction rests both at 158°F, main rests, 70 min at 143°F, 10 min at 155°F, 10 minutes at at 158°F.

The yeast is Wyeast 2206 from a previous carboy + 1 vial WLP 830. Primary ferment 2 weeks at 47, secondary 2 weeks at 41, then 4 months at 32. O.G = 1.060, F.G = 1.014.

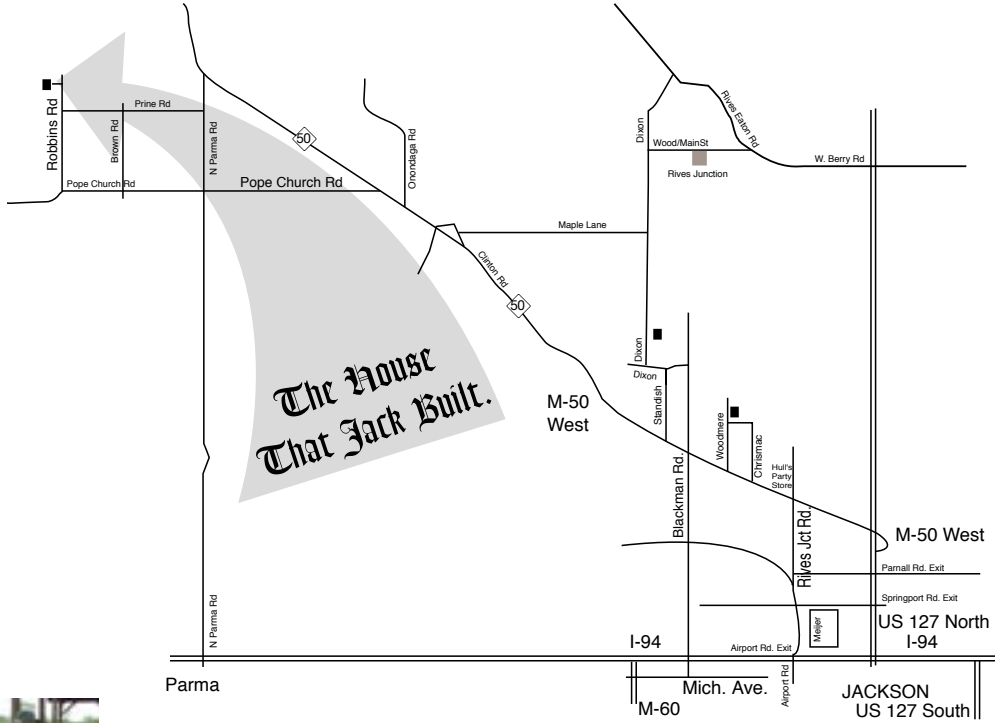
This Month's Meeting is at Jack Travoli's House!

From the South and East take 127 to M-50 West. Jack's address is 11035 Robbins Rd. It is relatively easy. M-50 to Pope Church Rd., just past Tompkins Center. Approximately 5 miles on Pope Church headed west to Robbins Rd. Its on the right, just before Pope Church has a sharp left curve. Turn right on Robbins, proceed about 1.25 miles north on Robbins. Jack's is the last and only driveway on the left on Robbins, just past a black mailbox, about 1/4 mile north of the side street Prine Rd. From the West, exit I-94 at Parma Road (exit 130) and go
